INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

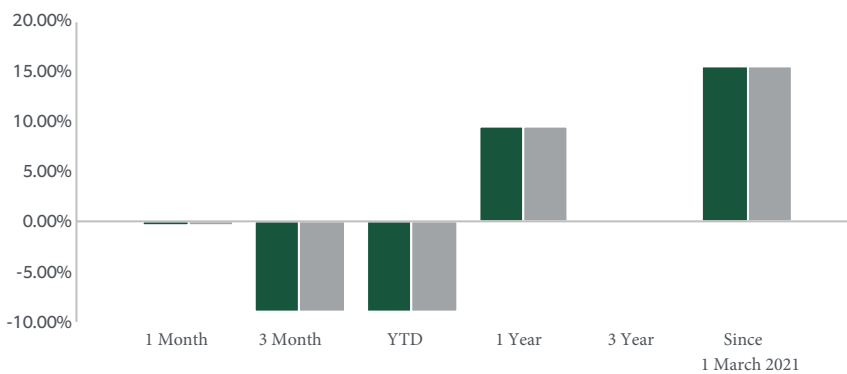
The Fund seeks to closely match the risk and return characteristics of the MSCI World Custom ESG Climate Series A Index (the Index). It is a custom Index calculated and screened by MSCI based on Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) criteria selected by Northern Trust which excludes certain companies not considered to meet sustainability principles. Amongst other things, the Index is looking to minimise climate related risks and maximise climate related opportunities.

INVESTMENT APPROACH

The Index employs a custom overlay and comprehensive, objective and risk-managed approach to sustainable investing to generate a unique climate change benchmark. The passive strategy was developed to define a thoughtful approach to fossil fuel divestment that provides opportunities to benefit from the transition into a low-carbon economy. The Index tilts towards companies benefiting from the energy transition and seeks to provide a hedge against systematic climate change risks. Key focus areas on climate-centered energy screening, custom ESG screening, Positive Green Tilts and Active Ownership.

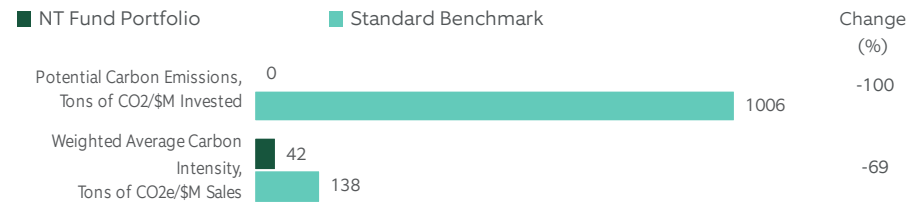
