2022 GRANT GUIDELINES

SMALL GRANTS

The Hazel Peat Perpetual Charitable Trust offers grants of up to \$10,000 for a one-year period only. A total funding pool of up to \$30,000 is usually available annually.

In 2022, the Trust's annual grant round will be held as part of the Small Grants Program, managed by Equity Trustees. A key aim of this Small Grants Program is to create efficiencies for smaller organisations wishing to submit an application for funding to trusts managed by Equity Trustees.

This Program provides applicants with an opportunity to submit one application that will be reviewed by multiple Grant Managers/Trustees/Advisory Boards increasing the likelihood for funding.

CRITERIA

The following criteria are used to identify applications for recommendation to the Trustees:

- Grants are for projects within Victoria only;
- There is no limit to the financial size of your organisation;
- The application should be for a small grant of up to \$10,000;
- Only one submission can be considered per applicant;
- Applications will be considered for untied funding, capacity building or project-based initiatives
- In recent times favourable consideration has been given to initiatives that benefit the following;
 - The elderly;
 - Disadvantaged youth;
 - Youth with a terminal illness;
 - Youth education;
 - Animal welfare (particularly horses and dogs); and
 - Medical research.

TAX REQUIREMENTS

Tax Concession Charity (TCC)

Deductible Gift Recipient (DGR) Status is NOT required to apply to the Trust.

Opening date: 9 February 2022

Closing date: 15 March 2022
