STATUTORY DECLARATION

Each parent or legal guardian must complete a separate statutory declaration.

1. The will of the late Frederick Richard O'Connell in establishing the scholarship scheme provides in subclause 3(h) that no person shall benefit who is or was a member of the Communist Party of Australia or a Communist Sympathiser or who is the child of such a person.
